23 Superintendent Corey stated that he had several updates for the board and one situation where he was asking for
24 the board's support with a vote.

26 Superintendent Corey explained that district administrators recently became aware of a residency issue and have
27 been working diligently to rectify the situation. He explained the general process involved if residency is
28 falsified; SAU 41 administrators work with local authorities and the proper receiving district to ensure all
29 matters are fully addressed.

31 Superintendent Corey gave a brief update regarding pending arbitration with the teacher's union regarding the
32 middle school schedule change. He briefly answered questions and assured the board he would update with
33 more information as it became available.

35 Superintendent Corey informed the board of a staffing change at the high school due to an unexpected
36 resignation.

38 Superintendent Corey explained that he would like to recommend the board allow a high school student to
39 complete this current year at the high school. Student needs to live outside of the school district at this time.
