

IMMUNIZATIONS OF STUDENTS

Any child being admitted to the Hollis Brookline Cooperative School District must present proof of meeting the physical examination and immunization requirements on their first day of school. Failure to comply with this provision may result in exclusion from school for the child.

Principals will notify parents or guardians of this requirement at the earliest possible date, so that the necessary plans can be made with the family physician or other medical resources to accomplish this standard prior to a child being admitted to school.

A child shall be exempted from the above immunization requirements if they present evidence from their physician that immunization will be detrimental to their health. A child shall be excused from immunization for religious reason, upon the signing of a form by the parent or guardian stating that the child has not been immunized because of religious beliefs.
